



1. PILLAR POINT – County Park
 - Day use only
 - Beautiful estuary
 - Boat ramp
 - Crabbing and clam digging

 - Historic tree farm
 - Permit required

3. BEAVER LAKE
 - Fishing
 - Picnic area
 - Bird watching
 - Kayaking
4. CLALLAM BAY VISITOR CENTER
 - -1-877-694-9433
 - Lodging, RV spaces and B&B
 - Medical clinic
 - Dining, mini-marts/deli - ATM
 - Fire station and EMT
 - Post office
 - Corrections center -- 2 miles
 - Gas/diesel stations
 - Auto Repair

5. SLIP POINT - Beach access
 - Marine life, tide pools, fossils
 - Beach loaded with agates
 - Historic light house site (now Coast Guard property)
6. CLALLAM BAY COUNTY PARK
 - Day use only.
 - Public restrooms.
 - A mile of sandy beach access.
7. MIDDLE POINT
 - Boat marina
 - Diner, lodging, RV, camping
 - Beach access

8. SEKIU -- Historic world class fishing town -- Noted, also, for Rosie the walking fish (see insert)

- Diner / lodging / RV spaces / camping, boat launches / marina's with docks
- Post office, shopping, convenience stores
- Historic old school restored to Community Center. Has spectacular view, used for civic functions as well as rented for special events such as weddings and other special gatherings.

9. AIRPORT – 2100 foot lighted runway with several hangars, hosts an annual fly-in event around Memorial Day coincident with the Shiftsure boat races.

10. HOKO/OZETTE ROAD – Cowan Ranch State Park, hiking trails, scenic drive (2 miles from Rosie)

11. LAKE OZETTE – A portion of Olympic National Park that is the 3rd largest lake in Washington State, famous for the two 3 mile planked trails to the Pacific Ocean (or 9 miles loop trip). Hiking, swimming, kayaking, fishing, lodging, camping and food. (26 miles from Rosie)

12. HOYT PROPERTY Beach Access – Scenic view with sandy beach (5 miles from Rosie) Several other view points on the way to Neah Bay

13. SHIPWRECK POINT – Natural Resources Conservation Area (3 separate pull-off points) (12 miles from Rosie)

14. SEAL AND SAIL ROCKS OVERLOOK – Marine and wildlife (18 miles from Rosie)

15. MAKAH MUSEUM – Native history and artifacts more than 500 years old (20 miles from Rosie)

16. MAKAH MARINA – Greatly expanded protected marina of major significance for commercial and recreational fishing (21 miles from Rosie)

17. CAPE FLATTERY – Most northwest point of contiguous USA. Easy 0.7 mile hike on boardwalk for view of Pacific Ocean,

Tatoosh Island, rugged bluffs and caves, marine and wildlife. (28 miles from Rosie)

18. HOBUCK BEACH – Spectacular sunsets, long sandy beach with several species of birds, lodging.

19. SHI SHI BEACH – A portion of Olympic National Park, pristine wilderness, Point of Arches rock formations

20. MARINE SANCTUARY – 50 miles protected coastline wilderness
